Overview:

The proposed subdivision is within Snoqualmie Valley #410 school district and the following are the public schools of record for students within this subdivision:

- Fall City Elementary School 33314 SE 42nd St, Fall City WA 98024
- Chief Kanim Middle School 32627 Redmond-Fall City Rd. SE, Fall City WA 98024
- Mount Si High School 8651 Meadowbrook Way, Snoqualmie WA 98065

Although Bus service is provided, Fall City Elementary School is just east of the proposed development. Students attending Fall City Elementary School will walk south along 332nd AVE SE utilizing the newly provided 6 ft. walkable shoulder. Students will then cross at the intersection of 332nd Ave SE and SE 42nd ST to the east. From this point, students will then traverse the existing widened shoulder along SE 42nd ST until reaching the School's main entrance.

Although Bus service is provided, Chief Kanim Middle School is ¼ mile west of the proposed development and the existing bus route is approximately equal distance south. Students attending Chief Kanim Middle School will walk south along 332nd AVE SE utilizing the newly provided 6 ft. walkable shoulder. Students will then cross at the intersection of 332nd Ave SE and SE 42nd ST to the west. From this point, students will

then traverse the existing widened shoulder along SE 42nd ST until reaching the School's main entrance.

Bus service is provided to Mount Si High School (Freshman Campus included). Students attending Mount SI School will have to walk south along 332nd AVE SE to the intersection of 332nd Ave SE @ SE 44th St [E] and catch the 37-am school bus. The 37-pm will reverse the route to drop the students off after school.



Fall City Elementary School

Prospective students attending School will start their walk path within the Fall City II subdivision that will contain joint use access driveways. Students will walk out of the subdivision to 332nd Ave SE and turn right heading south to SE 42nd ST. The frontage of 332nd Ave SE will contain a 6-foot shoulder allowing for students to walk safely to 42nd ST SE.



From here, students heading to Fall City Elementary School will then turn left on 42nd ST SE and walk east for approximately 500 feet along the existing widened shoulder. until they reach their destination.



Students heading to Chief Kanim Middle School will turn right on 42nd ST SE and walk west for approximately ¹/₄ mile along the existing widened shoulder until they reach their destination.



Students heading to Mount Si High School will continue south along 332nd Ave SE until they reach the intersection of 332nd Ave SE @ SE 44th St [E] and catch the 37-am school bus.
